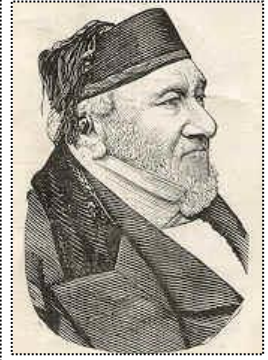

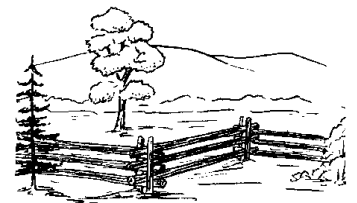
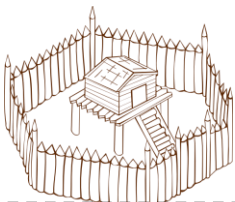

There are about 150 different quarters in Jerusalem.

Here is the story of the first Jewish neighborhood, called Mishkenot Sha'ananim, built outside the walls of the Old City of Jerusalem.

About 180 years ago, in England, there lived a rich Jew named Moshe Montefiore. He came to visit the holy Jerusalem and found many poor people there. He decided to help them. When he came back to England, he told his friends and started to collect money for the poor people of Jerusalem. When he came to visit the city again, he bought some land outside the Old City. He fenced off the area and built two houses, which looked like forts. He invited the poor Jews of the Old city to come to live there, but none of them agreed to live outside the Old City. They were afraid to live in the desert.

So Moshe Montefiore built a windmill. He thought that a flour mill would attract the Jews. In spite of this, only a few Jews went to live there, even though Moshe Montefiore gave them a regular sum of money every month, in addition to free homes. This was the beginning of the development of modern Jerusalem outside the city walls.

There are many quarters in Jerusalem which bear his name (הנושאים את שמו): Zichron **Moshe**, Kiryat **Moshe**, Ohel **Moshe** and Yemin **Moshe**.
