

Activity 1: Four Questions Wall

(Reflection on the meaning of Pesach through the Four Questions Reimagined)

1. Create 4 sections on the wall with four new questions:
 - a. *Why is this year different for me being in Israel?*
 - b. *Why does 'freedom' feel more complex after the period we have been through?*
 - c. *Why this year do we feel things more deeply than usual?*
 - d. *Why do we still have hope?*
2. Each participant has 4 sticky notes
3. Fellows go around the room and write responses to each of the four new questions
4. Do a 'gallery walk' by walking around and reading responses after everyone has finished
5. Give participants a new color sticky note to add questions or responses to what others said
6. Come back together in a circle and discuss if it is needed to have 'four new questions' and what does it mean for us? Review any themes that came up in the answers.
7. As a group, create 4 new questions
8. Close the session asking what "Next Year in Jerusalem" means today amidst this time of uncertainty in Israel.
