

Activity 3: Family Traditions at the Seder

(Share family memories of 'home' Passover traditions to create a new one together)

1. "My Family Does WHAT?!"

- Give each participant a paper and pen.
- Ask everyone to write down one random / funny / unique Pesach tradition from their home (anonymously).
- Collect all responses in a bowl.
- Read each tradition out loud one by one.
- After each one, the group guesses: *Whose family is this?*
- After guessing, the person can reveal themselves and (optionally) add a short explanation.

2. Create a New Group Tradition

- Ask: *"If we were to build OUR Seder tradition here, what would it include?"*
- Options:
 - Write a group ritual (song, question, or moment)
 - Create a "10th plague" relevant to today
 - Add a new symbolic food to the Seder plate
 - Participants can work in small groups or as one big group.
 - Ask each group to present their idea.

3. Reflection

- How are you leaving this session?
- How does it feel to be celebrating this Passover in Israel instead of with your family at home?
- What are you taking with you into Passover?
